FROZEN MAQUI FRUIT

- Maqui (*Aristotelia chilensis*) grows in the temperate forests in central and southern Chile and southwestern Argentina.
- Maqui harvest season takes place yearly between November and March.
- After harvesting, maqui berries are quickly frozen at -25°C, preserving quality, nutritional and physicochemical properties.
- Careful maqui picking by local gatherers ensures the integrity of nutrients is preserved in the final products.
- Maqui is collected by local communities, encouraging community participation and shared value, through sustainable wild collection focused on environmental care.
- Fruit harvesting processes comply with Fair For Life Certification by IMO Switzerland.
- Organic maqui complies with international organic standards, certified by IMO Switzerland.
