Item Establishment of residue standards of Pesticides, Animal Feed Additives and Veterinary Drugs in Foods

- Pesticides: Kasugamycin, Mepronil, Prosulfocarb, Tetraniliprole, Triforine
- Pesticide and veterinary drug: Carbaryl

See the “*MRL table*” for details of **the draft standards** on each chemical.

The Food Sanitation Act authorizes the *Prime Minister* to establish residue standards for pesticides, feed additives, and veterinary drugs, hereafter referred to as “agricultural chemicals”, in or on certain food commodities. Any food for which standards are established pursuant to the provisions in Article 13, Paragraph 1 of the act is not permitted to be marketed in Japan unless it complies with the established standards.

On May 29, 2006, Japan introduced the Positive List System* for agricultural chemicals in food. All foods distributed in the Japanese marketplace are subject to the system.

At this meeting, the Consumer Affairs Agency (CAA) would like to inform you of the proposals to modify or newly set the standards: maximum residue limits (MRLs) of the agricultural chemicals listed above for certain commodities under the Food Sanitation Act.

*, The aim of the positive list system on “agricultural chemicals” prohibits the distribution of any foods containing agricultural chemicals in amounts exceeding a uniform limit of 0.01 ppm generally considered to have no damage on human health in the Japanese marketplace, unless specific MRLs have been set.

<The procedure for submitting comments for Items>

The CAA will amend the existing standards and specifications for food as shown in this document. In case of any comments or queries, please inform *the contact person* via email or post in writing by Friday, **May 1, 2026**.

After the designated date above, it is necessary to submit comments to the enquiring point following the WTO/SPS Agreement.

If you wish to request Japan to adopt the same limits as your country's MRLs, you are asked to submit data supporting your country's MRLs, such as a risk assessment and residue data.

1. "Beans, dry" includes butter beans, cowbeans (red beans), lentil, kidney beans, lima beans, pegia, sultani, sultapya and white beans.

2. "Other pulses" refers to all pulses, except soybeans (dry), beans (dry), peas, broad beans, peanuts (dry) and spices.

3. "Other cruciferous vegetables" refers to all cruciferous vegetables, except Japanese radish roots and leaves (including radish), turnip roots and leaves, horseradish, watercress, Chinese cabbage, cabbage, brussels sprouts, kale, komatsuna (Japanese mustard spinach), kyona, qing-geng-cai, cauliflower, broccoli and herbs.

4. "Other solanaceous vegetables" refers to all solanaceous vegetables, except tomato, pimienta (sweet pepper) and egg plant.

5. "Other vegetables" refers to all vegetables, except potatoes, sugar beet, sugarcane, cruciferous vegetables, composite vegetables, liliaceous vegetables, umbelliferous vegetables, solanaceous vegetables, cucurbitaceous vegetables, spinach, bamboo shoots, okra, ginger, peas (with pods, immature), kidney beans (with pods, immature), green soybeans, mushrooms, spices and herbs.
6. "Other citrus fruits" refers to all citrus fruits, except unshu orange, citrus natsudaikai, citrus natsudaikai (peels), citrus natsudaikai (whole), lemon, orange (including navel orange), grapefruit, lime and spices.
7. "Other berries" refers to all berries, except strawberry, raspberry, blackberry, blueberry, cranberry and huckleberry.
8. 1. "Other umbelliferous vegetables" refers to all umbelliferous vegetables, except carrot, parsnip, parsley, celery, mitsuba, spices and herbs.
2. "Other solanaceous vegetables" refers to all solanaceous vegetables, except tomato, pimiento (sweet pepper) and egg plant.
3. "Other cucurbitaceous vegetables" refers to all cucurbitaceous vegetables, except cucumber (including gherkin), pumpkin (including squash), oriental pickling melon (vegetable), watermelon, melons and makuwauri melon.
4. "Other vegetables" refers to all vegetables, except potatoes, sugar beet, sugarcane, cruciferous vegetables, composite vegetables, liliaceous vegetables, umbelliferous vegetables, solanaceous vegetables, cucurbitaceous vegetables, spinach, bamboo shoots, okra, ginger, peas (with pods, immature), kidney beans (with pods, immature), green soybeans, mushrooms, spices and herbs.
5. "Other citrus fruits" refers to all citrus fruits, except unshu orange, citrus natsudaidai, citrus natsudaidai (peels), citrus natsudaidai (whole), lemon, orange (including navel orange), grapefruit, lime and spices.
6. "Other berries" refers to all berries, except strawberry, raspberry, blackberry, blueberry, cranberry and huckleberry.
7. "Other fruits" refers to all fruits, except citrus fruits, apple, Japanese pear, pear, quince, loquat, peach, nectarine, apricot, Japanese plum (including prune), mume plum, cherry, berries, grape, Japanese persimmon, banana, kiwifruit, papaya, avocado, pineapple, guava, mango, passion fruit, date and spices.
8. "Other nuts" refers to all nuts, except ginkgo nut, chestnut, pecan, almond and walnut.
9. "Other spices" refers to all spices, except horseradish, wasabi (Japanese horseradish) rhizomes, garlic, peppers chili, paprika, ginger, lemon peels, orange peels (including navel orange), yuzu (Chinese citron) peels and sesame seeds.
10. "Other herbs" refers to all herbs, except watercress, nira, parsley stems and leaves, celery stems and leaves.
11. "Other terrestrial mammals" refers to all terrestrial mammals, except cattle and pig.
12. "Edible offal" refers to all edible parts, except muscle, fat, liver and kidney.
